Adult Education

The general objectives of adult and out-of-school youth education shall be those contained in the statement of educational principles adopted by the Board (cf. 6120). The administration is charged with the responsibility to develop and implement specific objectives designed to provide appropriate adult educational opportunities for the citizens of the community. Fees necessary to implement these programs for adults and out-of-school youth shall be set by the administration prior to the development of each year's annual budget.

It shall be the responsibility of the administration continually to evaluate the program offerings, staff, materials, equipment, supplies, facilities and fee schedules to insure their compatibility with the needs of the adult community and the means of the school system.
