

# Good Time Tickets

Good time tickets are raffle tickets that are distributed by staff members to students in recognition of something positive.

## **They can be given for:**

- ❖ Good manners
- ❖ Helpfulness
- ❖ Good work in class
- ❖ A positive contribution to the community
- ❖ As a reward for games or competitions in class.

The staff member writes the student's name and signs their initials on the ticket and the student returns it to the ticket bucket in their homeroom. (Staff is not responsible for lost tickets)

Every week at Community Meeting all tickets are placed in a bucket and three tickets are drawn (2 for high school students, one for middle school students). Prizes will vary. A student must be present at community meeting and be on yellow level or above to win.

## **Tickets can also be used for other purposes:**

1. Three (3) tickets can be used to "buy off" a teacher detention. This is NOT an option for office detentions.
2. Five (5) tickets can be turned into the homeroom teacher to get an ice cream coupon that is redeemable at lunchtime with Mrs. Leroux.
3. If twenty (20) tickets are accumulated, students can turn them in for pizza party. These will occur approximately every 3 weeks.
